Agreement between Parent, Student and Teacher. **Please sign the back of this sheet stating that you have read the following terms and agree to this commitment.**

Contracting, Scheduling and Fees

- Lessons are contracted and scheduled in sets of 12 and are contained within a semester (fall, spring).
- Students may opt to take one or two semesters of lessons, but 12 lessons (one full semester) is the minimum.
- There is no drop policy, no pro-rating, no trial period and there will be no lessons carried over from one trimester to the next.
- The 12 contracted lessons must be completed during the semester for which they are scheduled.
- Rates for lessons are as follows: \$41/30-minute lesson (\$492/semester), \$57/45-minute lesson (\$684/semester), \$77/hour lesson (\$924/semester).
- Upper School students are encouraged to take at least a 45 minute lesson.
- Fees are billed directly to your PDS account through the business office.
- If all 12 lessons are completed early in the term, there is an option to add extra lessons. However, this would not be considered the beginning of a new set of 12.

Attendance and Cancellation Policy

- Lessons should be scheduled for a day and time that the student will be available every week throughout the term. Check sports schedules, outside activity schedules, family schedules, etc. before committing to the semester.
- **Before teaching can begin**, this contract, signed by teacher, student and parent, must be received. Teachers, parents and students should check their calendars thoroughly and plan each week of the semester. If there is a no-school holiday scheduled on the day of a lesson, the teacher and student should plan ahead for an alternate meeting time.
- On the contract, teacher, student and parent should plan for the 12 lesson days after consulting the PDS calendar and any family, athletic or other commitments.
- If a teacher must miss a lesson for any reason, that lesson will be made up within the semester at a mutually convenient time and place for both student and teacher.
- Faculty will make up one (1) lesson missed by a student, but only if 24 hours notice is given.
- Any student “no-show” will not be made up.
- Lessons missed due to snow days will be made up at a mutually convenient time.
- Lessons missed due to school trips, sports practices or contests, rehearsals, outside events, etc. will not be made up. (Can be the one (1) make up of the semester if proper notice is given. As stated above, alternate dates can be planned in advance to avoid cancellations close to the date.)
- All parties should view the scheduled 12 lessons as **contracted time and instruction** on which the parent, student and teacher can rely to be consistent.

- Families and teachers should have an open line of communication and an ongoing dialogue about progress, goals, scheduling. Please exchange current contact information (cell phone and email).
